- ▶ We understand your frustration with the website and appreciate your patience and your help as we work to fix the problems as quickly as possible.

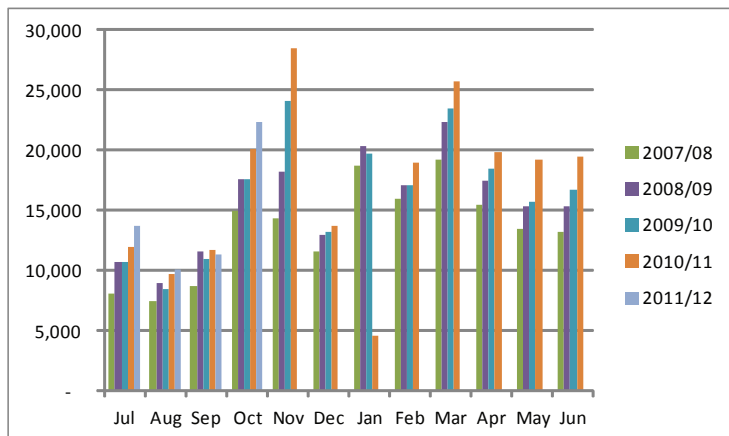

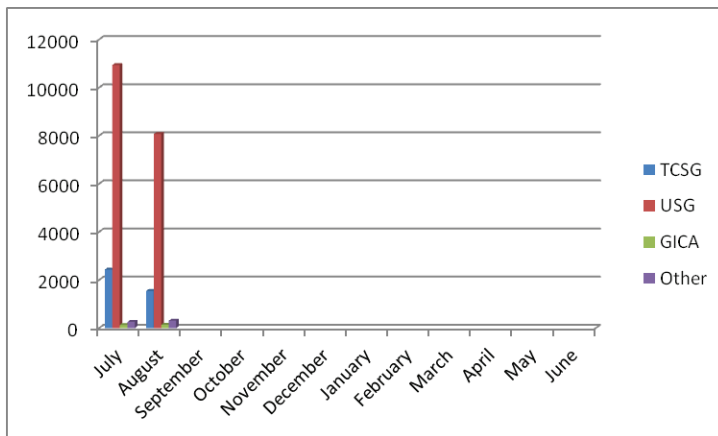

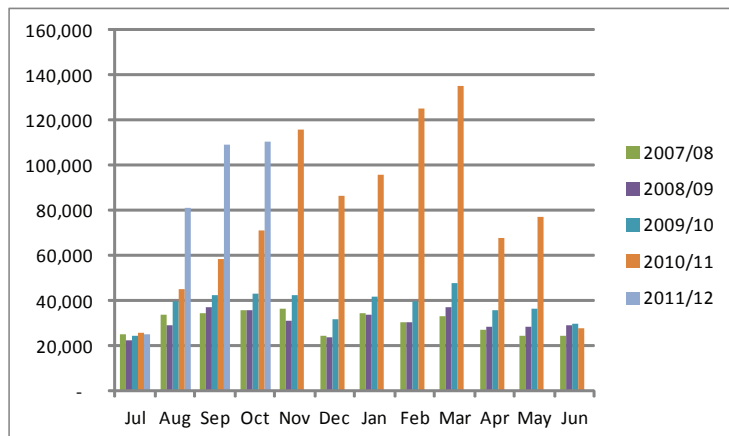
Admissions Applications



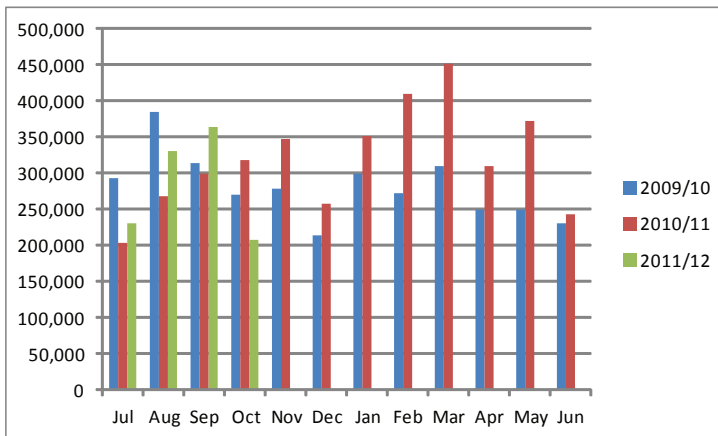
Admissions Applications by Type
