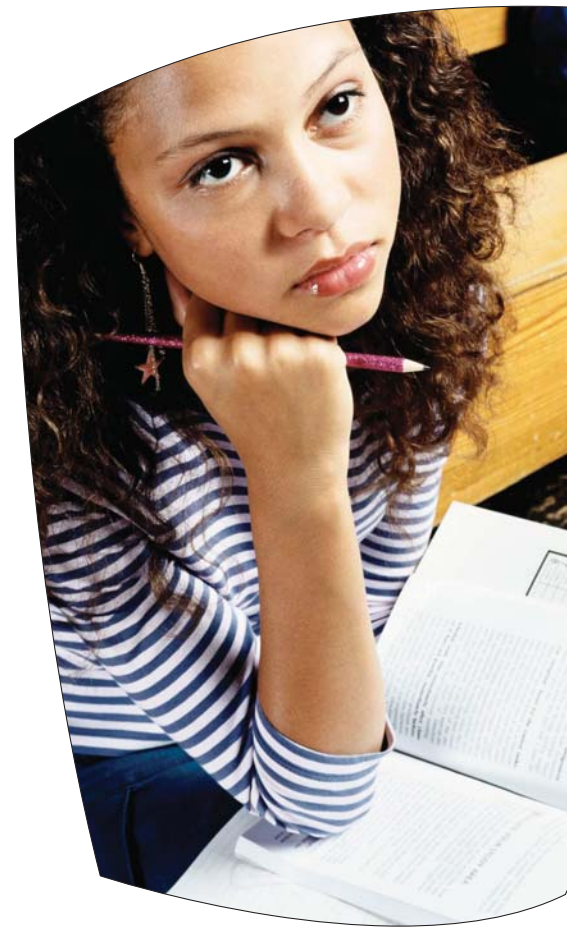
GAcollge411 February Update

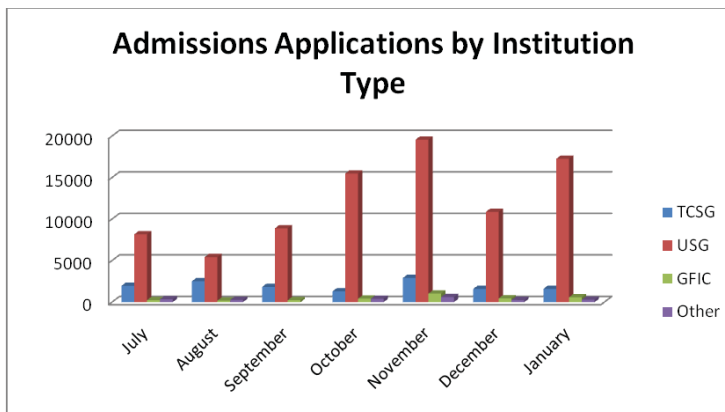
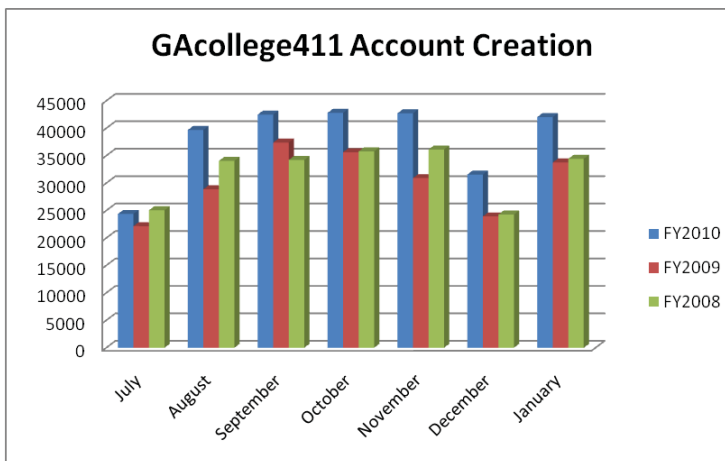
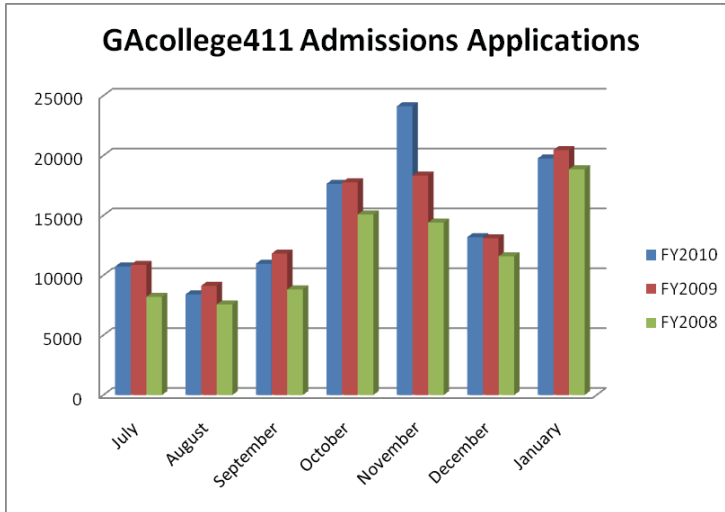
