

North Georgia College and State University ROTC Grant Program
FY2011 Regulations
Executive Summary of Substantive Changes

The following list highlights the major changes to the North Georgia College and State University ROTC Grant Program Regulations for FY2011. An attached chart outlines all changes.

- 1) The term “Appeal” was changed to “Administrative Review”. The definition was adjusted so that the use of the word appeal is removed from the regulations. An Administrative Review is a review of an eligibility determination by a Commission staff member to determine if the program laws, regulations, and policies were correctly applied to a student’s specific case.
- 2) A definition was created for “Study Away” and definitions for “Alternative Study” and “Study Abroad” were deleted. Alternative study and Study abroad programs are very similar, and so, were combined into one new term. The regulation section addressing these terms was also updated.
- 3) The Student Refunds section includes new language for how a post-secondary institution shall return funds to the HOPE Program upon a change in a student’s enrollment that requires a refund calculation to be performed.
