14 of 23	15 of 23	3609.1 Calculation of Refunds	<p>*Change 3609.1.c to "The Eligible Postsecondary Institution must determine the amount of the refund due back to the SEE program. The amount of the SEE award not determined to be owed back to the SEE program is retained by the institution to cover the institutions' cost for the portion of the school term that the student was enrolled.</p> <p>*Add 3609.1.c.1. The Eligible Postsecondary Institution must adjust the student's invoice in SURFER to the new award amount remaining after the refund is calculated within 45 days of the determination.</p> <p>*3609.1.c.2. If the Eligible Postsecondary Institution has sufficient funds on hand to return to the Commission the refund owed to the SEE program, it should return the funds within 45 days of the refund determination. The Eligible Postsecondary Institution would then collect the refund amount from the student. However, the student should not be reported with a "Refund Due" status to the Commission since the funds have been repaid to the Commission.</p> <p>*3609.1.c.3. If the Eligible Postsecondary Institution does not have sufficient funds on hand to return to the Commission the refund owed to the SEE program, the student is considered to have a "Refund Due" to the Commission and the institution must report the student to the Commission with a "Refund Due" status.</p>
